This supplement to The American Journal of Managed Care describes an economic evaluation of a fluocinolone acetonide (FAc) intravitreal implant for patients with diabetic macular edema (DME). The results show that from both a healthcare and societal perspective, the FAc implant is a costeffective treatment for patients with DME who have received a previous course of a corticosteroid with no clinically significant rise in intraocular pressure.
